## History

The eTech Ohio Commission was created in July 2005 to consolidate the state's investment in the telecommunications networks used by Ohio's public broadcasters and the K-12 community. Charged with advancing learning through technology, eTech Ohio:

- Supports a statewide telecommunications infrastructure that links classrooms and public broadcasting affiliates to each other and the internet;
- Provides funding and technical and telecommunications services to public broadcasters and the K-12 community;
- Administers funding for Educational Technology entities to support the development of multimedia educational materials;
- Provides teacher training and the development of educational resources to foster skilled, consistent and effective integration of technology; and
- Revolutionizes teaching and learning through web-based classroom management, innovative technology solutions and online educational tools to support the Ohio PK-20 educational community.
